They must be responsive to the needs and problems of the students while they are under his/her control. The instructor is expected to provide solutions to problems or direct the students to the proper source for help. Instructors must maintain the training facilities in a manner that aids effective learning by ensuring course materials are on hand and facilities are neat, clean, and safe. Manage students with disciplinary, academic, or administrative problems. The instructor is responsible for contacting the student's chain of command and course manager with any disciplinary problems, academic failures, and administrative problems. Follow guidelines IAW most current CMP issued by USAARMS.
