Must be a current on-board AGR in the State of MS within the grade(s) of E8 and E8.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of: E8. In order to be considered for this position applicants must meet the minimum qualifications as outlined on this announcement along with minimum appointment requirements.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed below WILL be submitted "AT A MINIMUM". If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted in the documents place citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the packet as eligible. The FTSMCS system will not allow you to go further without uploading a document in every category. If ASVAB scores reflected on your ERB are not current you must submit your latest ASVAB scoresheet with your application. Any applicants that do not include the new scores and do not meet the minimum score requirements will be disqualified.

!!!!All applicants will utilize the FTSMCS website (CAC Enabled) to apply for and submit applications!!!! The link and instructions are located at the bottom of the Careers page for Mississippi, titled FTSMCS Applicant Instructions. There will be no other avenue of submitting applications unless the system is non functional(ie. down for maintenance). 1. DA form 5500/5501 or Ht Wt statement from current unit CDR
2. DA 705 annotated with HT/WT data dated within the past 8 months
3. Current certified copy of ERB/ORB
4. Copy of NCOERs for the last 5 years (GAPs, overlaps, or non-rated periods must be explained in memorandum format) (include height & weight for each rating period *significant height fluctuations will be addressed in memorandum format)
5. Individual Medical Readiness Record (MEDPROS).
6. Letter from the security manager showing current status

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 00F

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must have a passing ACFT/AFT with DA 705 within the past 8 months, updated in DTMS
2. Individual selected must possess a secret security clearance.
3. Must be able to pass ACFT and meet the Army body fat standards IAW AR 600-9.
4. Must meet the Army medical retention standards in accordance with AR 40-501, Chapter 3.
5. Must not be currently flagged for favorable actions
6. Have no record of punishment under Article 15: Uniform Code of Military Justice; conviction by court-martial; general officer letters of reprimand filed in the official military personnel file; or derogatory information contained in IG records as screened by the DAIG.
7. No record of conviction by special or general courts-martial or civilian courts of offenses listed in AR 27-10 (Military Justice), chapter 24 or otherwise required to register as a sexual offender under AR 27-10, chapter 24.
8. Must be citizens of the United States (by birth or naturalization).
9. Must have a "1" under "S" factor or PUHLES.
10. Have broad experience and an Army background that reflects outstanding performance and demonstrated potential for future service.
11. Serve no consecutive details as an IG. The inspector General may approve consecutive details as an exception to the policy with the specific consent of the NCO concerned
12. Present good military bearing and appearance.
13. Must receive a GO from the DAIG vetting process, a NO GO will result in the applicant being disqualified.
14. Must successfully complete The Inspector General School on the first available training date after being selected for the position.
15. Remain in a deployable status for all required areas. Additionally, the tour length for the Assistance IG is a minimum of 36 and a maximum of 5 years (with TIG approval).
16. Have no record of civil conviction except for minor offenses
17. Associate's degree desirable
18. Must be on board AGR E8
19. Not be on assignment/transfer instructions
20. Must not be currently serving in a 00F position

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Serves on The Adjutant General's (TAG) personal staff. Assists the Inspector General (IG) with executing the IG functions of inspections, investigations, assistance and teaching & training for the Mississippi Army National Guard (MSARNG) and Air National Guard (MSANG). Provides assistance and mentorship to the over 10,000 Soldiers and Airmen of the MSARNG and MSANG. Determines the state of economy, efficiency, discipline, morale, Esprit-de-corps, and readiness providing feedback and counsel to senior leaders. Assists with the conduct of inspections and investigations as directed by TAG. Maintains both the Army and Air Force IG information systems and databases. Serve as primary Inspector General Intelligence Oversight Inspector for the state.
