Must be a current on-board AGR in the State of MS within the grade(s) of W1 and W4 or on-board AGR enlisted Soldier with an approved predetermination packet or certificate of eligibility.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of: W1 to W4. In order to be considered for this position applicants must meet the minimum qualifications as outlined on this announcement along with minimum appointment requirements.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed below WILL be submitted "AT A MINIMUM". If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted in the documents place citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the packet as eligible. The FTSMCS system will not allow you to go further without uploading a document in every category. If ASVAB scores reflected on your ERB are not current you must submit your latest ASVAB scoresheet with your application. Any applicants that do not include the new scores and do not meet the minimum score requirements will be disqualified.

 4. Predetermination memorandum issued by the proponent.

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POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 255N

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must meet the Army body fat standards IAW AR 600-9.
 2. Must not be currently flagged for favorable actions
 3. Must meet the security clearance requirements of the position.
 4. Must have a passing ACFT/AFT within past 8 months
 5. AGR enlisted Soldiers may apply if they have an approved pre-determination packet or a certificate of eligibility.
 6. Must be or be able to become 255N qualified within 12 months.
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BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Manages classified equipment, materials, and information in accordance with DoD COMSEC policies; securely stores classified material; maintains COMSEC access list; limits access to classified material to authorized personnel; maintains accountability of all COMSEC material; submits required accounting reports; briefs users and maintains records of initial briefings and debriefings; programs and distributes COMSEC devices; orders, receives, loads, and manages COMSEC keying material using the Key Management Infrastructure (KMI) and Simple Key Loader (SKL) and other devices; re-keys circuits as required. Ensures the integrity of the COMSEC/TRANSEC program; maintains records and files, issues and recovers COMSEC equipment in accordance with established policies; ensures prompt and accurate preparation, signature, and submission of account correspondence, messages, and accounting reports; provides written guidance concerning handling, accountability, disposition, and security of all equipment; writes, reviews, and analyzes COMSEC message traffic and documents to ensure compliance with current Joint COMSEC Management procedures; responds to crisis situations regarding the compromise or loss of COMSEC material.
