BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Plans, coordinates and supervises activities pertaining to operations, training, and mobilization for the 185th AV BDE and subordinate units. Prepares OPORDs, FRAGOs Training Plans, Mission Taskings, and Briefings. Attends Synchronization Resource Working Groups (SRWGs) to coordinate readiness and training. Prepares Yearly Training Guidance and Unit Training Plans IAW the Commander's guidance. Ensures TOC maintains a Common Operating Picture, battle tracking, and oversight of operations. Coordinates training exercises and schools to enhance unit readiness and prepare for mobilizations. Improves readiness of organic assets. Provides oversight to Army Training Requirements and Resources System (ATRRS) quotas and inputs, ATIS, and Defense Travel System (DTS) Establishes a direct line of communication with training and mobilization personnel at higher headquarters. Conducts preparatory visits to training sites to coordinate use of such sites, billeting, DFAC, ranges, training equipment, and other facilities required by the battalion. Reviews and edits standard operating procedures on all training related matters and supervises those procedures. Performs other duties as assigned.
