2. Must be able to communicate proficiently both orally and in writing.

3. Must have a minimum of 4 years of experience in HVAC, equipment utilization, and reading and utilizing building drawings and plans.

4. Must be able to obtain a government Common Access Card (CAC).

5. Physical conditions of such nature as to permit continuous, moderate to heavy work involving lifting, climbing, banding, stooping, and moving objects, with the ability to lift 20 pounds or more overhead.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: (Not all inclusive, will be fully explained during interview)

5. Monitors control panels that measure temperature, air pressure, air and water flow, relative humidity and electrical current to ensure proper functioning and integration of systems.

6. Tests and adjusts instruments to accommodate critical tolerances and accurateness. Recommends actions necessary to eliminate indoor and quality problems by utilizing EMCS controls systems and HVACR systems.

5. Performs other duties as assigned.
