- 9. Ability to use sound judgment in an atmosphere of high excitement while wearing a self-contained breathing apparatus.
- 10. Requires physical dexterity in climbing and maneuvering around high and tight places.

- 1. Respond to actual and potential emergencies and assist in coordinating tactics. Performs structural and crash fire-fighting duties as required.
- 2. Instructs fire fighters in classroom proficiency training as well as hands-on practical training and demonstrations in structural and crash rescue techniques, first aid, fire prevention and inspection and in the us of structural and crash firefighting equipment. Works with the Assistant Chief to improve individual and group performance of shift personnel.
- 3. Must sustain a working knowledge of construction features of various types of Aircraft, both civilian and military, to include helicopters and transient aircraft utilizing base facilities.
- 4 Will be trained in areas and functions of BAK-14 Aircraft Arresting System (ANG CRTC-Gulfport only).
- 5. Reports to the Assistant Chief the status of all Fire Protection Equipment and Personnel.
- 6. Schedules assignment of normal station duties in the maintenance of equipment and facilities.
- 7. Incumbent will accomplish duties as related to the fire service and shall familiarize themselves with the duties of Assistant Chief of Operations and assume those duties when directed by a senior fire officer.
