6. As assigned, inspects such equipment as fire hydrants, performs facility pre-fire planning/inspections, fire extinguishers, vehicle, tools, test hose etc.

7. Incumbent will accomplish all fire protection related duties as directed by a crew chief/senior fire fighter.

8. As assigned, accomplish station duties/maintenance IAW applicable operating instructions.
