- 5. Willingness to learn and obtain a working knowledge of building construction and base layout.
- 6. Incumbent accomplishes all fire protection related duties as directed by the Lead Firefighter and /or higher-ranking individuals.
- 7. Gains knowledge and understanding of KFCR departmental FDOI's, Plans/Programs, Air National Guard & Regulations.
- 8. Receives instructions both in the classroom & in practical demonstrations in the use of a variety of modern equipment and tactics, and from AFCEC Training Plan.
- 9. Must have working knowledge of any and all fire apparatus assigned to KFCR, inventory and how to operate and implementation of PS TAX to accomplish this.
- 10. As assigned, assist personnel with inspections of equipment such as fire hydrants, pre-fire plans of facilities/inspections, fire extinguishers, vehicle/apparatus, tools hose tests, and /or other assigned duties.
- 11. Other duties as assigned.
