Diagnoses mechanical and electronic circuity malfunctions using visual and auditory senses, test equipment, and technical publications. Removes, disassembles, repairs, cleans, treats for corrosion, assembles, and reinstall AGE accessories and components. Stencils and marks AGE. Services equipment with fuel, oil, coolant, water, hydraulic fluid, and air. Operates, cleans, inspects, and services AGE towing vehicles. Maintains vehicle forms. Provides dispatch service for AGE, including positioning equipment to support aircraft maintenance and flying operations.

  2. Diagnoses malfunctions and repairs AGE. Evaluates and performs troubleshooting on AGE before assigning repair

Prepares AGE for storage, shipment, and mobility deployment. Solves repair problems by studying drawings, wiring diagrams and schematics, and technical publications. Uses automated maintenance system to monitor maintenance trends, analyze equipment requirements, maintain equipment records, and document maintenance actions. Analyzes and repairs ground support equipment using conventional and digital multimeters, voltmeters, ohmmeters, oscilloscopes, circuit card testers and hand tools. Maintains AGE external fuel and grounding systems. Performs battery serviceability checks. Stores, handles, uses, and disposes of hazardous material and waste according to environmental standards.

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1. Knowledge is mandatory of: Principles of electricity, electronics, general mechanics, heating, refrigeration, pneumatics, hydraulics, and reciprocating and turbine engines.
- 2. troubleshooting, inspecting, repairing, and modifying equipment.
- 3. Use of automated maintenance systems; application of maintenance management techniques.
- 4. Interpretation of maintenance directives technical publications, drawing, writing diagrams and schematics.
- 5. Proper identification, handling, use and disposal of hazardous waste materials.
- 6. Qualification in and possession of AFSC 2A652 or at least three (3) years' experience performing or supervising functions such as inspecting, modifying, repairing, or troubleshooting AGE.
- 7. Must possess a valid state driver's license to operate government motor vehicles (GMV) in accordance with AFI 24-301, *Vehicle Operation*, or be able to obtain and maintain valid license.
- 8. Minimum Education Requirement of a High school diploma.
- 9. Must be physically able to lift 50 lbs. overhead, and ability to work in outdoor weather conditions including heat, rain, and cold conditions.
