Command Sgt. Maj. John T. Gist entered the United States Army in 1985. He completed Calvary Reconnaissance (19D) basic training and advanced individual training at Fort Knox, Kentucky in April 1985.

His military assignments include the 2nd Battalion, 198th Armored Regiment in Greenville, Miss.; 2nd Combined Arms Battalion, 198th Armored Regiment in Senatobia, Miss.; 1st Battalion, 155th Infantry Regiment in McComb, Miss.; 1st Squadron, 98th Cavalry Regiment in Amory, Miss.; Operations Sergeant Major (G3), Joint Force Headquarters in Jackson, Miss.; and Command Sergeant Major for 1st Squadron, 98th Cavalry Regiment.

Command Sgt. Maj. Gist's leadership positions include Bradley Commander, Section Sergeant, Platoon Sergeant, First Sergeant of Charlie Company 1st Battalion, 155th Infantry Regiment, First Sergeant of Headquarters Troop 1st Squadron, 98th Cavalry Regiment, and Command Sergeant Major for 1st Squadron, 98th Cavalry Regiment. He has been serving in his current role as the 155th Armored Brigade Combat Team Command Sergeant Major since July 2025.

His military education includes Primary Leader Development Course, Basic Non- Commissioned Officer Course, Advanced Non-Commissioned Officer Course, Maneuver Senior Leader Course and The United States Army Sergeants Major Academy.

Command Sgt. Maj. Command Sgt. Maj. Gist has been deployed five times with the Mississippi Army National Guard. His first deployment was in support of Operation Desert Storm/Shield in 1990, followed by a 2009 deployment to Iraq during Operation Iraqi Freedom, a 2018 deployment in support of Operation Spartan Shield/Inherent Resolve, a Civil Unrest Mission in the Nation's capital, and Joint Multi-National Training Group - Ukraine, based in Grafenwöhr, Germany.
