- 1. Congratulations on your selection to attend the 68W CMT course. The staff here at Medical Battalion Training Site (MBTS) will do everything possible to assure your success in the course. You will report **NLT 1530** on your report date. If you are on a profile you must bring a copy with you for in-processing. Report to MBTS, Building 1450, Camp Shelby, MS 39407. In-processing can be done in civilian clothes. Duty uniform will be OCPs for the entire course. Government quarters and meals are provided.
- 2. MBTS is affiliated with the U.S. Army Medical Center and School, and the National Registry of EMT's. MBTS conducts the 68W CMT course in accordance with TC 8-800 and the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians.
- 3. Students are required to be holding the 68W MOS in order to attend this course. Please check with your unit to ensure you are in MODS prior to arrival.
- 4. Students are to bring their body armor/LCE, gloves, eye protection, Kevlar/ACH, knee and elbow pads. This equipment will be required throughout the course in order to meet the graduation requirements.
- 5. Students that are required to fly, will fly into <u>Gulfport/Biloxi Regional Airport</u> on <u>the report date</u>. You must contact us at least 72 hours in advance to ensure that transportation will be available for you, if needed. Itineraries must be e-mailed to the e-mail address listed below. Students will not be released until the course end date. Do not schedule any return flights prior to 1000 on Sunday. Rental cars for those students flying are highly recommended because transportation on post is very limited. You must notify your unit of the arrival/departure dates and times prior to you attending the course. Ensure that your orders and itinerary are in compliance with this letter.
