BRIGADIER GENERAL JOHN C. NIPP

Brigadier General John C. Nipp began his military career enlisting in the Kentucky Army National Guard in 1990. After 1 year of enlisted service, Brigadier General Nipp was commissioned a 2nd Lieutenant through the University of Kentucky Army ROTC program. Brigadier General Nipp has completed numerous military educational programs to include the Field Artillery Officer Basic Course, Field Artillery Captain's

Career Course, Cavalry Leaders Course, Airborne School, Command and General Staff College, and the United States Army War College. He has been deployed in support of combat operations three times. Once to Somalia, Operation Restore Hope, and twice to Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Brigadier General Nipp has received numerous awards during his 34 years of both Active and Reserve service to include: (2) Bronze Stars, (3) Meritorious Service Medals, (4) Army Commendation Medals, (3) Army Achievement Medals and Combat Action Badge.
