SERGEANT MAJOR Tommy L. Morgan

Sergeant Major Tommy L. Morgan Jr. enlisted in the Mississippi Army National Guard in January 1996 and completed entry-level training under the Split Training Option at Fort McClellan, Alabama, qualifying as a Military Police (MP) Officer. Over a distinguished career spanning more than 30 years of continuous service, SGM Morgan has served in critical leadership positions at every echelon across both continental United States (CONUS) and outside continental United States

(OCONUS) environments.

In 2003, SGM Morgan deployed as an MP Squad Leader in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. Upon his return, he transitioned to the Active Guard Reserve (AGR) program, serving as the Admin NCO for the 113th Military Police Company. While assigned to the 113th MP Company, he served as the Training Police NCO in Brandon, Mississippi, and the Detachment Readiness NCO in Mendenhall, Mississippi. He deployed a second time in 2007, serving as an MP Squad Leader in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

In 2011 SGM Morgan was promoted to Sergeant First Class and served as the Readiness NCO for both the 113th and 114th Military Police Companies over a 5 year period. In 2016, he transitioned to the Mississippi Joint Force Headquarters (JFH) G3 Section, where he managed critical state-level programs as the Quota Source Manager, Annual Training Manager, Exercise Manager, Overseas Deployment Training Manager, and Operations NCO.

SGM Morgan was promoted to First Sergeant of the Joint Force Headquarters Detachment in Jackson, Mississippi, in 2019. In this role, he spent three years advising and working directly with the Senior Leadership of the Mississippi National Guard. In 2022, he transitioned to the Directorate of Military Support (DOMS) as the Non-Commissioned Officer in Charge (NCOIC), coordinating vital joint operations and domestic support to Mississippi emergency management agencies across Mississippi.

In June 2023, he was promoted to Sergeant Major and assigned as the Operations SGM for the 112th Military Police Battalion, where he successfully directed unit deployments in response to natural disasters and domestic security missions across the United States. SGM Morgan culminated his career following his selection in September 2024 as the Mississippi G3 State SGM, where he oversaw training development, operations, and exercises statewide.

SGM Morgan is a graduate of all levels of the Non-Commissioned Officer Professional Development System, culminating with Class 50 of the U.S. Army Sergeants Major Academy. He holds an Associate of Arts degree from the University of Phoenix and a Bachelor of Science degree from Liberty University.

His military decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (with 3 Bronze Oak Leaf Clusters), Army Commendation Medal (with 2 Bronze Oak Leaf Clusters), Army Achievement Medal (with 1 Silver and 1 Bronze Oak Leaf Cluster), and the Mississippi Magnolia Cross, alongside numerous other federal and state awards.

SGM Morgan is married to Gail Morgan of Richland, Mississippi. They have two children: Bayleigh, a speech-language pathologist, and Owen, a student at Mississippi State University studying engineering and a proud service member in the Mississippi Army National Guard.
