

CSM Rickie Fortner is the Garrison Command
Sergeant Major, Camp McCain Training Center,
Mississippi Army National Guard. The mission of
Camp McCain Training Center is to command,
operate, manage, and administer the resources of a
level III Garrison Training Center. Provide operational
support to all transient and tenant units and joint
forces activities for up to and including multiple
battalion sized elements, ensuring availability of all
necessary resources for successful completion of all
training objectives.

CSM Fortner is an Infantry NCO with over 36 years of service in the Mississippi National Guard, over 28 of those years have been with the 155th ABCT. He has served as a Mortar Section Leader, Infantry Platoon Sergeant, Infantry First Sergeant, Headquarters Company First Sergeant, Operations Sergeant Major, Battalion CSM, and Garrison CSM.

CSM Fortner has conducted two combat deployments in support of the Global War on Terrorism. From 2005 to 2006 he served as the Mortar Section Leader, Troop A, 98th Cavalry, FOB Lima and FOB Hit, Iraq and again in 2009 to 2010 as an Infantry Platoon Sergeant, Company A, 2-198th CAB, Q West, Iraq. In 2018 to 2019 he deployed to Kuwait in support of Operation Spartan Shield as Battalion CSM for 2-198th CAB.
